Research Analysis

The conference committee substitute to HB 1680 requires the district attorney's office to inform the crime victim that he or she has the right to utilize the automated notification system provided by the designated Oklahoma victim notification service provider for purposes of receiving information regarding the location of the defendant following an arrest, during a prosecution of the criminal case, during a sentence to probation or confinement, and when there is any release or escape of the defendant from confinement. The measure requires the Department of Corrections to give notice of the projected date of release of the inmate to the designated Oklahoma service provider within 60 days but not less than 7 days prior to the release of the inmate. The measure provides that opinions of the Court of Criminal Appeals designated for official publication must also be published on the Oklahoma State Courts Network website and must provide notice to all interested parties of the appeal not less than 2 business days prior to publication. The measure requires the Department of Corrections, rather than the district attorney, to make notifications prior to the placement of an inmate on the Electronic Monitoring Program.
