Research Analysis

The committee substitute to HB 1680 requires the Department of Corrections to give notice of the date of release or date of anticipated release of the inmate to the designated Oklahoma service provider not less than 10 days prior to the release of the inmate. The measure provides that opinions of the Court of Criminal Appeals designated for official publication must also be published on the Oklahoma State Courts Network website and must provide notice to all interested parties of the appeal not less than 2 business days prior to publication. The measure requires the Department of Corrections, rather than the district attorney, to make notifications prior to the placement of an inmate on the Electronic Monitoring Program.
