Research Analysis

The PCS directs the State Department of Health, contingent upon the availability of funds, to provide grants to a grant supervising entity for the purpose of reimbursing private organizations for program expenses that assist women to carry their children to term. To be eligible to receive a grant, a private organization must be registered as a not-for-profit corporation in the state and assure that such funds will not be used to encourage or counsel women to have, provide, or refer her for a medically unnecessary abortion.
