Research Analysis

The introduced measure allows for the use of school buildings and property by youth groups listed in U.S. Code 36 (ex. Big Brothers-Big Sisters of America, Boy Scouts of America, Girls Scouts of The United States of America) at times other than instructional time. Beginning with the 2017-18 school year, school principals must allow representatives of such groups the opportunity to speak with and recruit students to participate in their organizations during school hours. The group must provide written notice to the school principal that they wish to speak to students and the principal will notify the group of a specific date and time available.
