Research Analysis

HB 1716, as introduced, requires that persons who reside in a nursing facility, specialized facility or an assisted living center for more than 30 days, and who require a prescription for a behavioral medication, to have a pharmacogenomics profile conducted. The measure also requires that the facility provide appropriate behavioral health services to each resident in need of such services.
