The Proposed Committee Substitute for HB 1720 requires new insurance policies written after January 1, 2018, to provide a discount, rate reduction, or other related adjustments for new insurable property built to resist loss due to tornado or catastrophic windstorm events. The property must be certified as constructed according to Appendix Y of the 2015 Oklahoma Uniform Building Code or the Institute for Business and Home Safety FORTIFIED Home High Wind and Hail Standards. Insurable property is defined as including single-family residential property and modular homes but excludes most manufactured or mobile homes.
