Fiscal Analysis

HB 1721, as introduced, <u>removes two felonies</u> which currently exist in statute. The removed felonies and their associated penalties are as follows:

The average cost of incarceration in the custody of Oklahoma DOC is \$52.24/day or \$19,067.60/annually. Eliminating these crimes may reduce incarceration rates. This is contingent upon how many people are typically convicted for these two crimes.
