Fiscal Analysis

HB 1721, as introduced, removes two felonies which currently exist in statute. The removed felonies and their associated penalties are as follows:

Crime	Penalty
Any non-authorized law enforcement officer boarding a bus with a dangerous or deadly weapon	Felony: imprisonment of not more than 10 years and/or a fine of not more than \$10,000
Any person who discharges a firearm or hurl or place in the path any missile at, into or within any bus terminal or transportation facility	Felony: imprisonment of not more than 5 years and/or a fine of not more than \$5,000

The average cost of incarceration in the custody of Oklahoma DOC is \$52.24/day or \$19,067.60/annually. Eliminating these crimes may reduce incarceration rates. This is contingent upon how many people are typically convicted for these two crimes.
