**Research Analysis**

The measure provides an exemption from the prohibition against dual office holding to county officers who are also reserve force deputy sheriffs, reserve special agents with the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control, or reserve municipal police officers. Current law only provides this exemption to state officers.
