**Research Analysis**

HB 1819 prohibits a health benefit plan that covers prescription eyedrops from denying coverage for a refill prescription under certain conditions, including:

- Enough time has passed that 70% of the dosage should have been used;
- The prescription indicates that more is needed;
- The refill does not exceed the additional amount needed; and
- The prescription is covered.
