The introduced measure requires the Board of Regents that govern the state's universities and colleges, and the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, to submit a report to Governor and Legislature that includes the job description of the institution's president, including performance metrics; challenges and opportunities the institution is facing; an assessment of the institution's senior offices; and a succession plan for the presidency. The report must be updated annually by January 1.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1828, as introduced, requires by January 1, 2018, the state higher education governing boards to each submit a report to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives which includes specified information. The report will be updated and specifically submitted on an annual basis by January 1. The measure has no significant fiscal impact.
