Research Analysis

HB 1832, as introduced, modifies the definition of *sex trafficking* and *severe forms of trafficking in persons*. Modifies the list of conditions under which the court and DHS may place siblings in separate permanent placements to include that placing the siblings together would be contrary to the safety or well-being of any of the siblings. Finally, the bill lowers the age at which foster children in DHS custody who are to receive a copy of their credit report from 16 to 14.
