**Fiscal Analysis**

The Full PCS to HB 1834 transfers control of the revolving fund titled “County Community Safety Investment Fund” from the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to the Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services in accordance with State Questions 780 and 781 – money saved by reclassifying some criminal offenses (SQ 780) would utilize money saved to allow counties to fund community rehabilitation programs with the savings (SQ 781).
