Research Analysis

HB 1835 allows for secure detention of a child who has been adjudicated in need of supervision and has willfully violated a court order. The measure also removes a provision that currently allows for a fine not to exceed \$300, placement in a juvenile detention center for not more than 10 days, or both, for a willful violation of a court order.

The bill further allows for a child taken into custody and in need of supervision after running away to be temporarily placed in a juvenile detention facility.
