Fiscal Analysis

FULLPCS1 for HB 1837 relates to the Oklahoma Education Lottery Act. New language provides that for each fiscal year, the first \$50 million dollars of net proceeds of net proceeds shall be transferred to the Oklahoma Education Lottery Trust Fund. All of the proceeds remaining after such apportionment will be transferred to the Oklahoma Education Lottery Trust Fund. The Oklahoma Lottery Commission will submit a specified written report annually.

Further, the annual maximum percentage for administrative costs, not including specified items, will not exceed 3% of sales. And, the portion of lottery annual net proceeds deposited to the Oklahoma Education Lottery Trust Fund that exceeds \$50 million will be appropriated by the Legislature on a cash basis to be allocated by the State Department of Education to public schools on a certain average daily membership basis and for specific purposes.

Lottery Commission personnel are estimating no increase in funds for FY-18. The combined impact of the changes is estimated to add \$110 million availability for education programs over the next five years.
