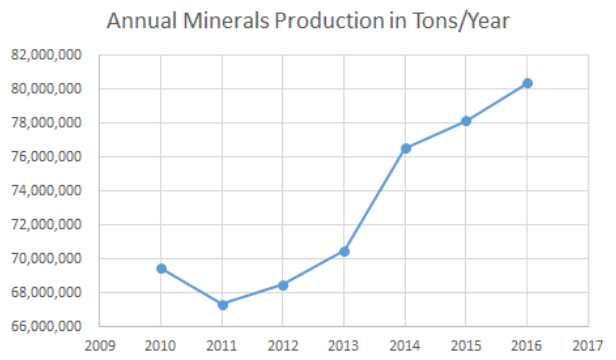
HB 1844 increases from \$0.01 to \$0.0125 the Department of Mines fee per ton of mineral produced in non-coal mining operations.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1844, as introduced, will create a positive fiscal impact for the Department of Mines. This bill increases an existing fee from \$.01 per ton of mineral produced to \$.0125 per ton. Based upon an average annual reported production level of 73 million tons, the Department of Mines estimates a revenue increase in the range of \$182,500 to \$200,000.
