## **Fiscal Analysis**

The FA3 on HB 1845 simplifies and clarifies the laws regarding training which shall be offered by DPS. DPS will be responsible for developing training for those motor agents who would like to offer REAL IDs. This amendment gives DPS the ability to charge the motor agents for the training and the flexibility to offer it in various forms (online, on-site, etc.).

DPS is responsible for furnishing all equipment required by the motor agent to process REAL IDs without a cost to the motor agent. It is expected DPS will absorb the cost via the increase to license fees and the potential training fee.
