Fiscal Analysis

The amendment to the third floor amendment on HB 1845 clarifies and specifies requirements regarding the REAL ID training required to be facilitated by DPS for motor agents. This amendment requires DPS to hold trainings at on-site locations which shall not exceed 4 hours and stipulates DPS shall not charge the motor agents more than \$50.00. The amendment also allows DPS to hold on-line training if it is approved by the Dept. of Homeland Security.

These costs are intended to be absorbed by DPS through the increase of license fees and the training fee.
