HB 1845 creates a REAL ID Compliant Driver License or Identification Card to allow persons to obtain a compliant REAL ID. Persons may also choose to not obtain a driver license or identification card which is not REAL ID compliant. Fiscal Analysis

- Increases the license fees for both commercial licenses and class D licenses by \$2.00;
- Increases the renewal fee for licenses;
- Creates a new fund, the Public Safety Enhancement Fund which will acquire the \$2 fee from those motor license agents who do not process REAL ID applications or renewals. The funds will be used by the Legislature through appropriations for enhancing public safety in the state.
