Hb1856, as introduced, creates the Task Force for the Study of the Oklahoma Tax Code composed of 16 members appointed by the Governor, President Pro Tempore and Speaker. **Fiscal Analysis**

Provisions of the measure include reference to reimbursement of task force members:

Members of the Task Force shall be reimbursed as provided by the appointing authority.  
[Subsection D]

Should reimbursement include travel costs in a manner set forth in the State Travel Reimbursement Act ([74 O.S., Section 500.1 et seq](#)), the appointing agencies (House of Representatives, Senate, Governor) may incur costs associated with the reimbursement. A reliable estimate cannot be provided, as the actual potential reimbursement costs will depend on the frequency and location of task force activities and the range of travel required by task force members.
