Fiscal Analysis

The measure modifies the funding structure of the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission (OHRC) by setting its operating budget for the initial year (FY-18 – effective date July 1, 2017) at \$3,300,000 and the funding is to be adjusted based on annual change in the Consumer Price Index for all-urban consumers (CPI-U).

Revenue currently accruing to the General Revenue Fund (GRF), estimated to approach \$1,421,300 in FY-18, based on certification documents. The most recent full appropriation for OHCE – FY-17 stands at \$1,743,834. Assuming that, at best, the agency would otherwise receive an appropriation in FY-18 of a similar amount, the elimination of the appropriation against the revenue loss to GRF would result in a gain of approximately \$322,534 in FY-18.

OHRC is authorized, at prescribed intervals, to adjust the apportionment percentages of adjusted gross revenue from gaming to provide resources to meet the approved budget amount. No changes are made to the apportionment of gaming revenue accruing to the state. According to OMES CORE system reports, total agency expenditures approached \$ 3,740,446 in FY-08 and were approximately \$ 3,104,533 in FY-16
