Research Analysis

HB1858, as introduced, modifies the apportionment of horsetrack gaming revenue and revenue from fees, fines, reimbursements and sales of material of the Horse Racing Commission. The measure creates the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission Operational Expenses Revolving Fund and redirects revenue going to the General Revenue Fund from various sources to the newly created fund. The measure also clarifies that gaming may be conducted by an organization licensee on Christmas Day and strike language limiting the number of hours of gaming that may be conducted on any given day or week.
