Fiscal Analysis

HB 1862, as introduced, relates to the Oklahoma Educational Television Authority and allows, if authorized, for personnel from a specified foundation to carry out duties of the Authority. Further, the Authority may appoint the chief executive officer of a foundation to serve concurrently as the Executive Director of the Authority and chief executive officer of the foundation. The Executive Director will be compensated solely by the foundation.

The savings is estimated at \$108,000 if there is no longer state payment of an Executive Director.
