Research Analysis

The introduced measure permits school districts to donate food to a nonprofit organization through an authorized on-campus nonprofit representative or designee who is directly affiliated with the school as a teacher, counselor or PTA member. The food may be received, stored and redistributed at the school at any time, and school employees may assist in preparing and distributing the food as volunteers for the nonprofit organization.
