Research Analysis

The SA specifies that the summary suspension of licensure or certification may be ordered without compliance with the requirements of the open meeting act.

The bill clarifies and updates language within the Nursing Practice Act and authorizes a majority of the officers of the nursing board to suspend a license if deemed necessary to protect the health, safety or welfare of the public prior to a complaint being filed with the board. The licensee must be notified by letter within seven days after the summary suspension and the letter must include the date of the proposed disciplinary hearing. The disciplinary hearing must be held within ninety days of the date of the summary suspension letter.
