Research Analysis

HB 1893 creates the Oklahoma Remote Patient Monitoring Reimbursement Act. The bill defines remote patient monitoring and provides that those services be designed to allow individuals to remain in a residential setting and improve quality of care. The measure also establishes qualifications for remote patient monitoring services and for the equipment used. Finally, the measure requires all health insurance and employee benefit plans to cover remote patient monitoring services to the same extent as other telemedicine services.
