**Research Analysis**

HB 1899 relates to liens on personal property. The measure allows for certain wrecker liens and changes title application requirements for out-of-state or tribal titled vehicles. The measure modifies certain procedural requirements for obtaining title and specifies that class AA wrecker operators are not required to obtain salvaged title on unrecovered-theft-titled vehicles.
