## **Research Analysis**

HB 1907 modifies the leave of absence available to state and local employees who are members of the National Guard or any United States military branch when called up for active or inactive duty. Current law allows for state employees to receive their full regular pay during the first 30 regularly scheduled work days of the leave of absence. HB 1907 restricts this time period to not exceed 240 hours.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

Limiting the number of paid hours during certain leaves of absence may positively impact the budget of an agency that has personnel whose absences exceed 240 hours. Neither the Office of Management and Enterprise Services nor the Military Department currently have the ability to track the total number of state employees affected by this provision, making it difficult to accurately estimate aggregate statewide impact.
