Research Analysis

The committee substitute stipulates that an application for disinterment must include the consent of the next of kin. If a dead body or fetus is to be disinterred and reinterred in the same cemetery then a permit will not be required. However, a notice of disinterment and reinterment must be completed, signed by the funeral director and next of kin, and then submitted to the State Registrar within five days. The Disinterment Permit and Notice of Disinterment and Reinterment will be available from the State Registrar.
