Research Analysis

HB 1944 removes the use of the omnibus resolution to approve rules. The measure returns to the administrative rule approval process used prior to the adoption of HB 2055 in 2013. The measure provides for the disapproval of any proposed rule by the adoption of a Joint resolution. Any rules not disapproved by Joint resolution shall be deemed approved.

The measure repeals Title 75, Section 308.3 relating to the Omnibus Resolution.
