Research Analysis

The second Proposed Committee Substitute for HB 1948 provides that any person or entity operating lawfully and in the course of business may use public roads, including right-of-way and easements, for the purpose of placing temporary pipe and supporting equipment for transportation and disposal of waste water used in oil production. The measure requires consent prior to pipe or equipment placement from the Department of Transportation, boards of county commissioners, or property owners, depending upon the location and ownership of the road. The bill further requires a person or entity using roads or highways in this manner to completely repair or replace any damage, injury or other change caused by the temporary pipe placement.
