Research Analysis

The SA to HB 1968 allows an individual who purchases a child care facility to continue to operate the facility at the same star level as the previous owner for 90 days if the same personnel are employed. If, at the end of 90 days, the owners have met all the requirements established for facility owners, they may continue to operate at the same star rating. If the requirements are not met, the facility will be prohibited from caring for children. Finally, the measure requires that DHS be notified of a change in ownership prior to the new owner assuming operations of the facility.
