**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB 1999 creates a joint review committee to review all agency rules, including during the interim. The measure provides that all rules promulgated by every agency, board and commission shall sunset once every 4 years. The joint review committee is to review such rules to make a determination as to allowing the rules to sunset. The bill provides for the appointment of the joint review committee.
