The CS for HB 2001 exempts certain hunters from tagging requirements for bears. Hunters with lifetime hunting or lifetime combination licenses do not have to tag bears, as well as hunters listed in 29 O.S. 4-112 who are exempt from the annual hunting license requirement.

Fiscal Analysis

The CS to HB 2001 provides exemptions for certain persons to the purchase of a hunting tag for bears. According to the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation, this measure will have a negative impact of \$17,678.
