**Research Analysis**

The floor amendment removes paragraph A and modifies paragraph B. Beginning with the 2018-19 school year, the State Department of Education must annually publish on its website within one click of the homepage a report that lists all increases in wages, salaries, rates of pay or fringe benefits, and any changes to job class, excluding changes that did not result in an increase in pay. The Department must publish the information within 60 days following the submission of personnel reports certified on October 15 and July 15.
