**Research Analysis**

The SA provides that no dispensing protocol will be required for the prescribing and dispensing of naloxone as long as it is dispensed only by, or under the supervision, of a licensed pharmacist.

Additionally, if a prescriber determines periodic refills of maintenance medication is not medically necessary then a pharmacist may exercise their professional judgement to dispense varying quantities of a maintenance medication per fill-up to the total number of dosage units as provided for on the original prescription. This will not apply to scheduled medications or any medications for which a report is required under the controlled substance database.
