HB 2159 requires the court clerk to notify the Oklahoma Tax Commission when a defendant fails to enter a plea or timely appear for arraignment. The Tax Commission is to cancel the current registration on any motor vehicle registered by the defendant and place a hold on any future registrations until such time as the defendant satisfies the court.
