**Research Analysis**

The measure authorizes counties, municipalities, schools and all other political subdivisions to display replicas or statues of historical documents such as the Ten Commandments, Magna Carta, and Bill of Rights on public property. Finally, the measure authorizes the Oklahoma Attorney General to provide legal defense to a political subdivision in the event the display is challenged in a court of law.
