**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB 2186 would allow motion picture theaters to be licensed to sell low-point beer.

The measure repeals Title 37, Section 163.2, Title 37, Section 163.25, Title 37, Section 506, and Title 37, Section 521. Sections 162.2, 163.25 and Section 506 are set to repeal by effect of SB 383 effective October 1, 2018. Section 521 relates to acts authorized by the various licenses.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The CS on HB 2186 will allow movie theaters to purchase mixed beverage licenses. A new mixed beverage is \$1,530.00 and a renewal is \$1,430.00. There will be a positive fiscal impact but the exact amount is contingent upon how many movie theaters purchase and renew a license.
