Impact:	Increases the maximum amount of two fines

Research Analysis

The measure increases the distance between a bicyclist and a passing motorist from three feet to five feet. Further, the measure increases the penalty from \$500 to \$1,000 to any motorist who violates this provision causing a cyclist to crash or fall. Finally, the measure increases the fine from \$1,000 to \$10,000 for a person who violates this provision resulting in the death of a person.

Fiscal Analysis

The introduced version of HB 2191 increases the maximum of two fines. The amounts are as follows:

Violations which result in collision, crash, or fall causing serious physical injury to a person	No more than \$500.00 \$1,000
Violations which result in the death of another person	No more than \$1,000 \$10,000

Amount of fine revenue generated for the state is contingent upon the amount of violators and the amount at which the fines are set.
