**Research Analysis**

The Proposed Committee Substitute for HB 2216 requires a hospital to provide notice to a health plan enrollee when certain health care providers who may provide services to the enrollee may not have a contract with the enrollee's insurance carrier. The measure also requires a noncontracted provider to give notice to a health plan enrollee, as well as a good-faith estimate of charges and a disclosure that the provider will either accept the assignment of benefits for the plan's allowed amount or balance-bill the enrollee.
