## **Fiscal Analysis**

The CCR on HB 2281 creates graduated penalties for certain crimes, reducing some from felonies to misdemeanors, reducing/increasing fines as well as the mandatory lengths of sentences. The average cost of incarceration for one individual in the custody of DOC is \$58.70/day or \$21,425.50/year. The measure could potentially generate cost savings. The exact amount is contingent upon how many individuals are convicted of these crimes, the length of the sentences, and/or the fines imposed.
