Fiscal Analysis

The FA1 version of HB 2281 creates graduated penalties for certain crimes, reducing some from felonies to misdemeanors, reducing/increasing fines as well as the mandatory lengths of sentences. The average daily cost of incarceration for one individual in the custody of DOC is \$52.24 or \$19,067.60 yearly. This could potentially create cost savings. The amount of savings is contingent upon how many individuals are convicted of these crimes, the length of the sentences and/or fines imposed.
