## **Research Analysis**

HB 2281 contains the Governor's Justice Reform Task Force recommendations relating to unlawful delivery of goods, false personation, credit or debit card crimes, forged instruments or coins, larceny of lost property, theft of aircraft, automobile or construction equipment and theft of a controlled dangerous substance. The measure creates graduated penalties based upon the value of the property.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

The introduced version of HB 2281 creates graduated penalties for certain crimes listed below:
