Fiscal Analysis

The FA2 on HB 2286 specifies those inmates who are not eligible for parole consideration. The amendment also adds a section which specifies those inmates who are either: 65 years of age and have served no less than 10 years of their sentence or those over 55 who are deemed medically frail by DOC can be eligible for parole. This can decrease incarceration rates for DOC if some inmates are able to apply for parole. The decrease in incarceration rates and the actual financial amount saved is contingent upon how many inmates fit into these categories and how many are granted parole.
