Research Analysis

HB 2287 requires the Department of Corrections to conduct a risk and needs assessment on all new prisoners sentenced to custody of the Department and develop an individualized case plan based on the assessment. The Department is to develop a case plan for each inmate and ensure that the plan is achievable prior to the inmate's parole eligibility date. The Department must also forward the case plan to the Pardon and Parole Board and electronically submit a progress report on each parole-eligible inmate's case plan to the Parole Board.
