**Research Analysis**

The Proposed Committee Substitute for HB 2299 directs the owner of a wind energy facility to submit notifications to operators of any oil or gas operations, or holders of oil and gas leases, within the same area. The initial notice required to be submitted to the Corporation Commission under current statute would have to be sent to those operators or lessees within 6 months of that notification, and an additional notice of intent to construct would be required 60 days before beginning construction.

**Fiscal Analysis**
