Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB2306 creates two new civil court fees: \$25 for each subpoena issuance and \$25 for filing a motion to enter.

Fiscal Analysis

The CS on HB 2306 creates a new fee of \$25 for counties for issuing a subpoena in civil cases for each person. In calendar year 2016, there were 2,600 subpoenas issued in civil cases. It can be estimated that ~\$65,000 in new revenue will be generated across the state for county court funds.

HB 2306 also creates an additional fee for filing motion to enter in civil cases of \$25. This revenue would stay with county funds. The exact amount of revenue increase is contingent upon the amount of motions filed.
