Research Analysis

HB 2322 includes firearm and ammunition components in the state preemption of legislation regarding such items. Allows persons adversely affected by any order, ordinance or regulation promulgated or enforced by a municipality or other political subdivision in violation of the preemption provisions to bring a civil action against the person, municipality or political subdivision. The measure requires the court to award reasonable expenses if the court grants a final determination in favor of the person adversely affected or if the order, ordinance or regulation in question is rescinded, repealed or otherwise abrogated after a lawsuit has been filed. The measure defines the terms "person adversely affected" and "reasonable expenses".
