## **Research Analysis**

The Senate Amendment to HB 2324 requires that a permit holder who contracts with or authorizes another person to shoot from the aircraft shall have the authorized person sign a disclosure stating that the person is aware of the dangers of aiming and shooting over the horizon.

Engrossed HB 2324 allows those permitted by the Department of Agriculture to shoot depredating animals from an aircraft and to authorize other unlicensed, unidentified persons to shoot from the aircraft, as well. No specific pilot's license or liability insurance is required.
